Why does ISO 26000 still hold high value today?



- **The valuable content includes:** (i) the definition of social responsibility of organizations, (ii) the identification of seven areas of responsibility, (iii) the implementation of stakeholder engagement and due diligence, and non-certifiable standards.
- **The valuable formulation process includes:** (i) stakeholder participation and consensus, (ii) involvement of UN agencies and the OECD, and (iii) alignment with public global governance.

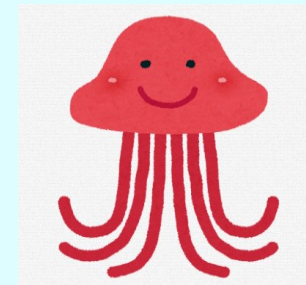
What is needed to promote ISO 26000 among SMEs and help the socially vulnerable?

- To promote dissemination that takes into account the needs of SMEs and the socially vulnerable, **while fully recognizing the value of ISO 26000.**
- The use of standards related to the basics of social Issues **should be free as part of ISO's social responsibility.**



What should we do to enable ISO 26000 to effectively enhance ESG standards?

- **SGN should compile and strongly advocate for a statement to reaffirm that its content and formulation process still hold high value today.**
- **The statement should include key points that ISO26000 can make the ESG standards by ISO appropriate.**



- How can we apply ISO 26000 on planet Mars in the near future?



- It is to **maintain the high value of ISO 26000 into the future** and to avoid making easy amendments that prioritize the profits of CSR businesses.
- The systematic review of ISO 26000 should be conducted with the participation of stakeholders and international organizations, **similar to the formulation of the original ISO 26000.**
